All meetings start at 12:15 in the CBA Building (321 South Plymouth Court); exact room locations are posted in the CBA Building lobby that day. You do not need to be a CBA member to attend - but if you are, then you can join the any committee's membership roster and can receive CLE credit.

If you are not a CBA member, then by going to www.chicagobar.org you can view the weekly e-bulletin for general meeting announcements. There is no dress code (but you should think about the impression you make if you wear torn jeans or baseball caps). You can bring a lunch from outside (water is provided in each meeting room), or if a CBA member, swipe your card for the soup/sandwich du jour (they will bill your CBA account about \$10 per lunch).

If you are interested in attending a CLE program (as opposed to a monthly meeting), you need to register through the CBA website and pay the student rate.
