## GRADING SYSTEM effective August 25, 2003

Letter grades were given in accordance with the following scale of grade points:

For graduation, an overall average of 2.00 was required.

## PASS/FAIL OPTION:

The Pass grade is given when the student has done at least C work in the course. These units are not included in computations of grade point average. A Fail grade under this option is equivalent to F, which is included in the cumulative grade point average.

## September 1975 — April 1977

Letter grades were given in accordance with the following scale of grade points:

A (Excellent)	4.0 grade points per semester hour
B (Good)	3.0 grade points per semester hour
C (Average)	2.0 grade points per semester hour
D (Passing)	1.0 grade points per semester hour
F (Failing)	0.0 grade point per semester hour
WF (Withdraw/fail)	0.0 grade point per semester hour

For graduation, an overall average of 2.15 was required.

## September 1972 — June 1975

Letter grades were given in accordance with the following scale of grade points:

A (Excellent)	92 to 100 incl., 4.0 grade points per semester hour
B (Good)	85 to 91 incl., 3.0 grade points per semester hour
C (Average)	78 to 84 incl., 2.0 grade points per semester hour
D (Passing)	72 to 77 incl., 1.0 grade points per semester hour
F (Failing)	71 or below, 0.0 grade point per semester hour

For graduation, an overall average of 2.15 was required. However, an average of C or 2.00 grade points was required both for each semester and overall for promotion.

## September 1960 — June 1972

Letter grades were given in accordance with the following scale of numerical equivalents and grade points:

A (Excellent)	92 to 100 incl., 3.0 grade points per semester hour
B (Good)	85 to 91 incl., 2.0 grade points per semester hour
C (Average)	78 to 84 incl., 1.0 grade points per semester hour
D (Passing)	72 to 77 incl., 0.0 grade points per semester hour
F (Failing)	71 or below, -1.0 grade point per semester hour

A weighted average of C or 1.00 grade point, was required each semester and overall for promotion. However, for graduation, an overall average for the entire course of 1.10 was required.
