EIGHTEENTH ANNUAL JOHN MARSHALL LAW SCHOOL
STUDY TRIP TO THE CZECH REPUBLIC
OCTOBER 13 THROUGH OCTOBER 24, 2010

The 18th Annual John Marshall Law School Study Trip to the Czech Republic will depart Chicago on Wednesday, October 13 and return to Chicago on Sunday, October 24, 2010. We will fly direct from Chicago to Zurich and then to Prague on Swiss Air. We will return to Chicago from Prague via Zurich and, therefore, will clear customs in Chicago.

The trip will begin in magical, historic Prague where we will spend Thursday night. We will also have time to see some of the sites and monuments in Prague and then partake in our "Welcome" dinner at the new Jama Restaurant, located near the National Theatre. On Friday morning, we will have a program with the Czech Bar Association. Friday afternoon we will depart for the city of Brno, the largest city in Moravia and the Judicial Capitol of the Czech Republic. We will stay at the Hotel Continental and will remain at the hotel for six nights.

On Saturday morning, October 16, we will depart Brno on a guided excursion in Southern Moravia for possible visits to either/or the Moravian Karst to see the caves, Pernstejn castle, a mighty Moravian castle built from the 13th century or Tisnov-Porta Coeli, the convent Porta coeli (Gate of Heaven) which is one of the oldest historic sites in the Czech Republic. Sunday morning, October 17, we will depart for sightseeing in the area of Lednice. Possible sites include the Castle of the Princes of Liechtenstein, a beautiful neo-Gothic type castle with a great park and gardens, visit the Southern Moravian town of Mikulov and nearby region and enjoy dinner and a wine cellar experience. On Tuesday, our attorney participants will present a program for the Masaryk law students on American law. We will all have the opportunity to visit the Masaryk University Faculty of Law. While in Brno, it will also be possible to visit the courts and governmental offices and/or to have additional time for shopping, attending museums and concerts, and sightseeing in Brno.

Wednesday evening, October 20, we will have the always popular reception at the Hotel Continental. This is a wonderful opportunity to visit with the many friends we have made over the years, especially our exchange students, their families, Faculty members of Masaryk Faculty of Law, and other guests. We will return to Prague early on Thursday, October 21, and truly have an opportunity for sightseeing. On Friday you will have a choice to do one of two things: (1) continue touring Prague and surrounding areas of interest or (2) take a train to tour the city of Dresden, stay overnight and return late Saturday afternoon. On Sunday morning, October 24, we will depart Prague to Chicago via Zurich.

The estimated cost for the trip, including round trip airfare on Swiss Air (Chicago/Prague via Zurich) and hotels (including breakfast) is approximately \$3,150, single occupancy. The cost per person for double occupancy (second person sharing room) is \$2,900. We have been driven by the rising cost of fuel and the lower exchange of the dollar to increase the cost. We have been notified that additional fuel surcharges may be added to the cost of the airfare. If that is the case, we will notify all participants for additional payment. Also, we recommend that participants purchase travel protection insurance. We will mail the insurance information to you upon your receipt of registration.

Attorney participants are eligible for continuing legal education credit hours for their participation in either the Czech Bar Association and/or A Day of American Law.

THE JOHN MARSHALL LAW SCHOOL/18TH ANNUAL CZECH LEGAL STUDY TRIP

As a group, we will leave Chicago in the evening on Wednesday, October 13, flying to Zurich and transferring to Prague, where we will arrive on Thursday, October 14. On Sunday, October 25 we will fly to Zurich from Prague and return to Chicago from Zurich.

1. The price of the trip package is \$3,150 per person, single occupancy and \$2,900 per person, double occupancy.
2. The package price includes: roundtrip airfare and taxes from Chicago to Zurich, Zurich/Prague and return; group ground transport to and from hotels and for group events, tickets for group events for the weekend trip and tips for guides, bus drivers, and entrance fees during group tours, and hotel accommodations with breakfast each day. If one has assisted you personally on some favor, it is always appreciated to receive a tip. Tram tickets are available in the hotel or designated Kiosks for travel within the cities we will visit.
3. A deposit of \$1,000 per person is due by June 13 for each participant. The balance of \$2,150, single occupancy and \$1,900 double occupancy is due July by 30. All payments must be made by check (payable to The John Marshall Law School) or by credit card; Master Charge, Visa, American Express or Discover. All tickets will be issued by Swiss Air with a departure date of October 13 and a return date of October 24, 2010.
4. The John Marshall Law School will accept no responsibility for personal expenses incurred by any member of the travel group. A valid passport is required to travel to the Czech Republic. No visa is required of US travelers for stays up to 30 days in the Czech Republic and Germany.
5. All fares and rates are based on tariffs, rates and foreign exchange levels and current fuel surcharges in effect on April 15, 2010, and are subject to change. The ticket holder, not The John Marshall Law School, is responsible for additional airline charges such as fuel surcharges and additional airport charges. From July 14 to August 31, 2010, the cancellation fee is \$300 plus any airline cancellation penalty. If a cancellation is received after ticket issuance of September 1, 2010, the ticket is non-refundable. Cancellations must be made in writing and the effective date is the date received by The John Marshall Law School.
6. Prior to ticketing, a couple of persons may deviate their travel dates only, provided they travel one way with the group. Fare difference resulting from deviation may apply. Any additional ticket deviations cannot be considered as part of the group count and will be considered as individual travelers, priced and ticketed at applicable published fares.
7. The John Marshall Law School shall not be liable for any loss, damage, injury, accident, delay, or irregularities by reason of default or through the act or omission of any person or company performing or rendering services during this trip. We recommend the purchase of travel protection insurance. Pre-existing conditions accepted if insurance is purchased within 10 days from receipt of deposit.
