SPRING 2007 REFUND POLICY

WITHDRAWAL FROM INDIVIDUAL COURSES:

After January 30, 2007 there will be no refunds on withdrawals from individual courses.

COMPLETE WITHDRAWAL FROM THE LAW SCHOOL:

For students who withdraw COMPLETELY from the Spring semester, the Law School retains the following tuition:

Withdrawal after registration, but before classes begin ..... \$400.

During the first two weeks of class ..... 10% of tuition

After the end of two weeks of class, but before the end of the fourth week..... 20% of tuition

After the end of four weeks of class, but before the end of the fifth week ..... 30% of tuition

After the end of five weeks of class, but before the end of the seventh week..... 40% of tuition

After the end of seven weeks of class, but before the end of the eighth week ..... 50% of tuition

After the end of eight weeks of class, but before the end of the ninth week ..... 60% of tuition

After the end of nine weeks of class ..... 100% of tuition

\*The JMLS REFUND POLICY set forth above applies to the Spring and Fall semesters.

**THE REGISTRATION FEE IS NON-REFUNDABLE**
