Awarding Diplomas

The John Marshall Law School will award diplomas at the conclusion of the fall and spring semesters and the summer term. Absent extraordinary circumstances, as determined by the Dean, to receive a diploma, a student must have completed all graduation requirements by the date the Registrar establishes for faculty to submit grades for graduating students. In addition, absent extraordinary circumstances, the student must not have any pending code of conduct matters, admission application amendments, criminal charges, or holds.
